Grape variety:	100% Pinot Noir
Production region:	Loire Valley, next to the Muscadet Appellation (Atlantic side)
Soil type:	Micaschist soil
Age vines	Between 15 and 25 years old
Density:	6500 plants/ha, Guyot pruning.
Yield:	65 hl/ha
Vinification:	Vibrating sorting table. Pressing in pneumatic presses No Oak. Classic maceration for 15 days. malolactic fermentation. Ageing in Stainless steel.
Tasting comment:	Beautiful cherry-ruby color dress. The nose has notes of flowers, blueberry, flint and leather. The mouth is rich harmonious and elegant. A great balance of soft tannins with a beautiful persistence.
Accompanies:	White meat, chicken, cheeses...
Storage:	5 years
