Grape variety: 100% Melon de B.

<u>Region of production</u>: Loire Valley, close to Atlantic Ocean, near the village of Vallet, in the Appellation Muscadet Sèvre et Maine.

Soil Type: Granite

Exposition: Hillside, very rocky South

Density: 6500 vines/ha

Yield: 30 hl/ha

Vines ages: 40 years

<u>Vine-growing:</u> Guyot pruning, controlled natural green cover. Organic approach (organic fertilizer, use of pheromones, tillage). <u>Winemaking process</u>: Vibrating sorting table. Pneumatic press and temperature-controlled fermentation. Aged of fine lees for 10 months in 10 hectoliters ovoid vats, then bottled after fining.

Bottling: August 2020

Accompanies: Scallops, Lobster, Grilled fish, Creamed chicken

Stawberries sabayon. Storage: 2 to 6 years
